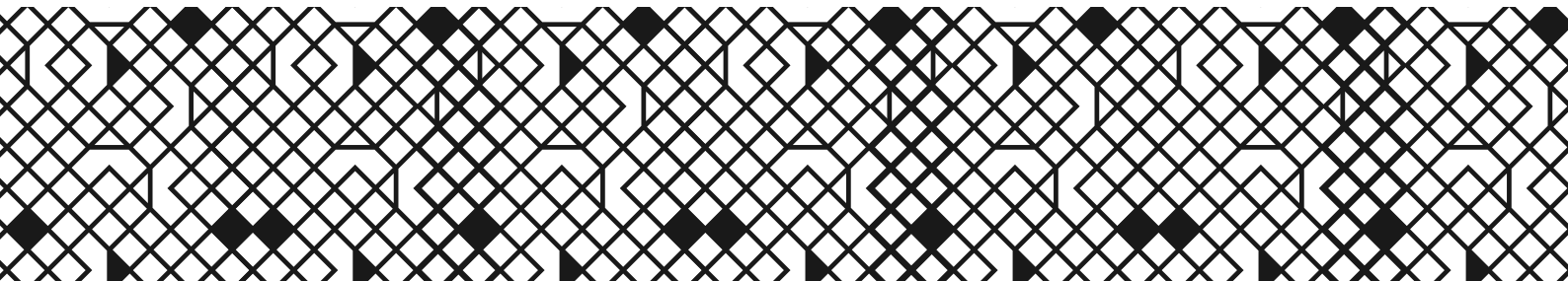

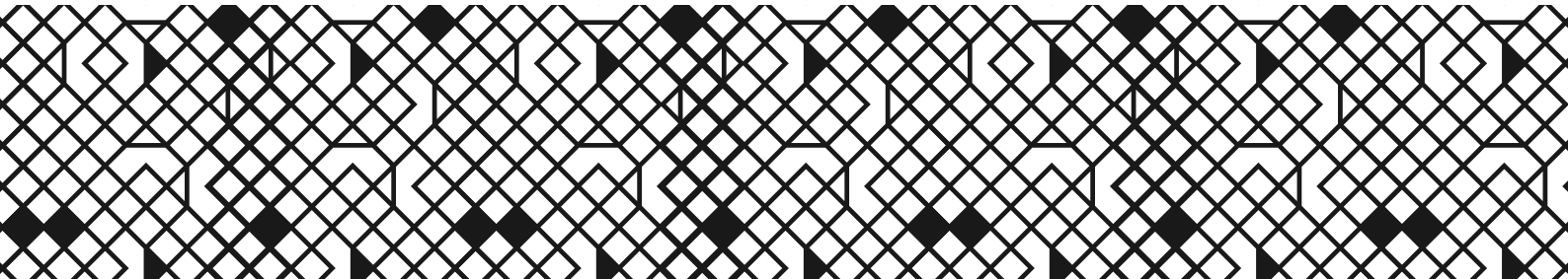

MUSEUM OF ISLAMIC ART

The Museum of Islamic Art (MIA) is one of the flagship projects of Qatar Museums, under the leadership of its Chairperson, H.E. Sheikha Al Mayassa bint Hamad Al Thani. The Museum offers a stunning variety of high-end venues for all types of events, all of which ensure an unforgettable experience.

The Atrium

- **Location:** On the first floor where the heart of the museum is, the Atrium is a grand hall and indoor space.
- **Capacity:** 600 guests – round table style
1000 guests – stand-up reception style

The Majlis

- **Location:** Near the main entrance of the museum.
- **Capacity:** 20 guests, U-shape
16 guests, Majlis Style





MUSEUM OF ISLAMIC ART

The Auditorium

- **Location:** First floor
- **Capacity:** 195 guests – theatre style in fixed seats
Foyer: 200 guests – stand-up reception style

The Western Courtyard

- **Location:** An elegant outdoor courtyard with fountains with views of the Corniche.
- **Capacity:** 700 guests – stand-up reception style
250 guests – round table style

The Central Courtyard

- **Location:** An outdoor area between the Education Centre and the main museum building with a breath-taking skyline view looking at the garden with the sound of the fountain.
- **Capacity:** 800 guests – stand-up reception style
400 guests – round table style



The Classroom

- **Location:** Museum of Islamic Art Education Centre
- **Capacity:** 40 guests – U shape
100 guests – theatre style
100 guests – stand-up reception style (foyer)

MIA Park

The MIA Park is a social place which can host year-round activities, including film screenings, sports events, art workshops and extra exhibition features. MIA Park is a dynamic place for children, families and art enthusiasts, featuring cultural, educational and recreational activities surrounded by green spaces and a long promenade. The venue offers a great landscape for large, outdoor events. It is available for hire on an exclusive or nonexclusive request basis.

- **Location:** Museum of Islamic Art
- **Capacity:** 20,000 guests





NATIONAL MUSEUM OF QATAR (NMOQ)

- **Capacity:** 400 guests – stand-up reception style
200 guests – round table style

- **Location:** Ground floor – courtyard (outdoor)
- **Capacity:** 2000 guests – stand-up reception style
800 guests – round table style

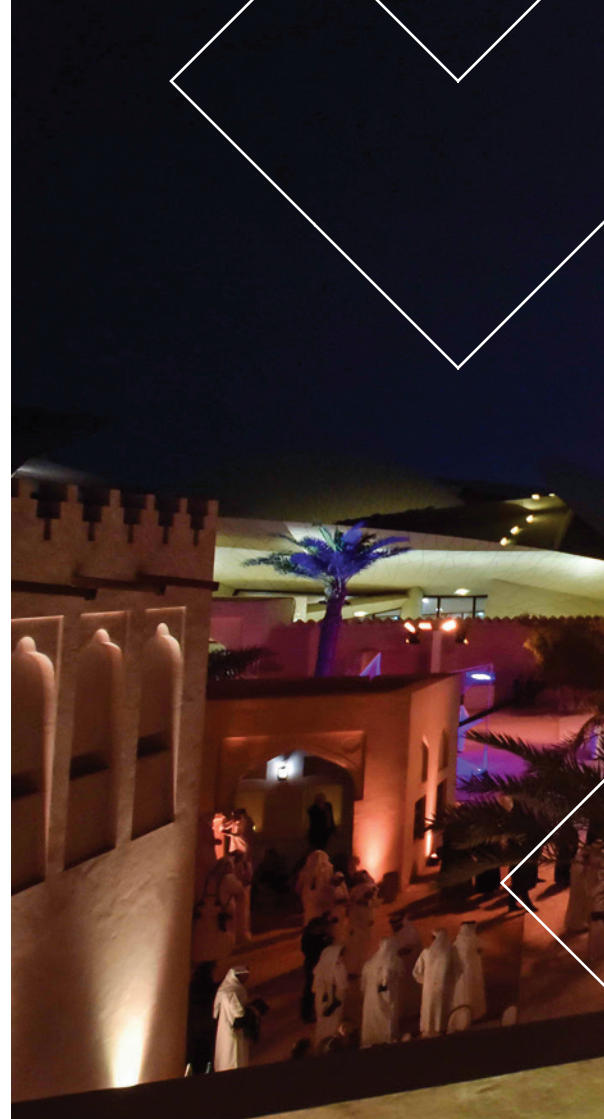

- **Location:** Ground floor – Lagoon area (outdoor)

400 guests – round table style

The Auditorium

- **Location:** First floor – Darwish Al Far Theatre.
- **Capacity:** 213 guests – theatre, fixed seats
200 guests – stand-up reception style
(auditorium foyer)





Welcome Room

- **Location:** First Floor
- **Capacity:** 25 guests – U shape
40 guests – theatre style

Big Board Room

- **Location:** Fourth Floor
- **Capacity:** 22 guests – board room style

Small Board Room

- **Location:** Fourth Floor
- **Capacity:** (up to) 10 guests – board room style





QATAR MUSEUMS GALLERY AL RIWAQ

This venue, in front of MIA Park, hosts exhibitions that get people talking. With a diverse schedule of exhibitions and a vast space, Qatar Museums Gallery Al Riwaq will always have a one-of-a-kind exhibition for your guests' viewing as well as an indoor café. With its large reception area that provides the chance for formal and informal meetings and events and its magnificent view overlooking the MIA Park, this venue can be the perfect location for hire.

The Atrium

- **Location:** Opposite the Museum of Islamic Art, in the park.
- **Capacity:**

FIRE STATION ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

The Fire Station Artists in Residence is a new hub for creative exchange of the arts. This venue with its vast plaza and diverse spaces can serve as a contemporary venue for different types of events.

The Plaza

- **Location:** within the Fire Station Building
- **Capacity:** 1000 guests – stand-up reception style
600 guests – round table style

The Annex

- **Location:** Fire Station Annex building, upper level, above Café #999
- **Capacity:** 120 guests – stand-up reception style
80 guests – round table style



The Theatre

- **Location:** On the ground floor of the Fire Station Annex
- **Capacity:** 112 seats



MATHAF: ARAB MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

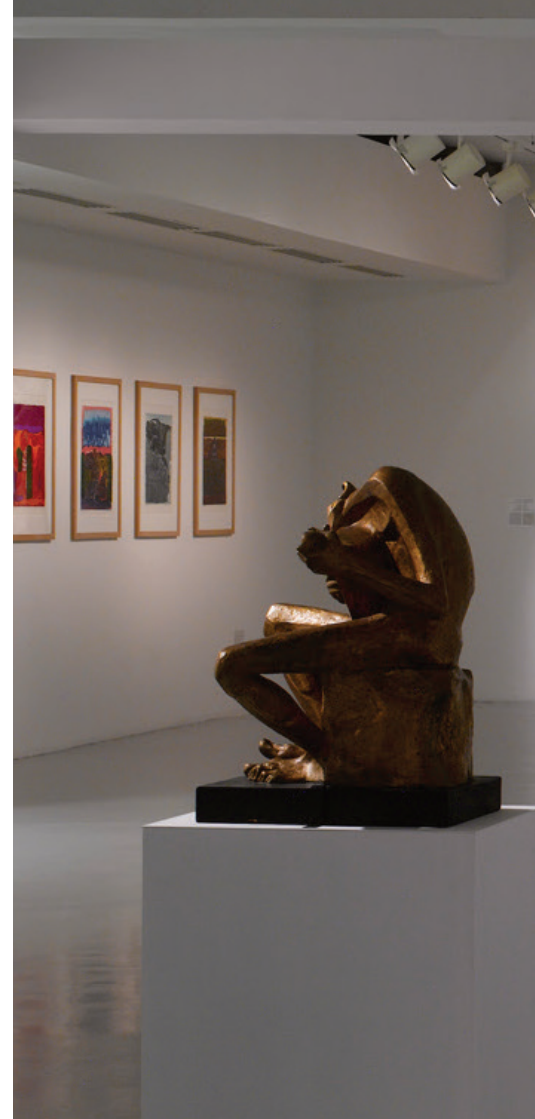
A boundary-breaking museum that asks the local community to celebrate the present-day creativity of the Arab world. It is one of the most engaging, contemporary, and lively museums within Qatar, and is an informal space near Qatar Foundation to be used, not just visited.

The Atrium

- **Location:** Main entrance, at the heart of the museum.
- **Capacity:** 250 guests – stand-up reception style
150 guests – round table style

The Sculpture Park

- **Location:** Front entrance of the museum
- **Capacity:** Reception and seated gala dinners



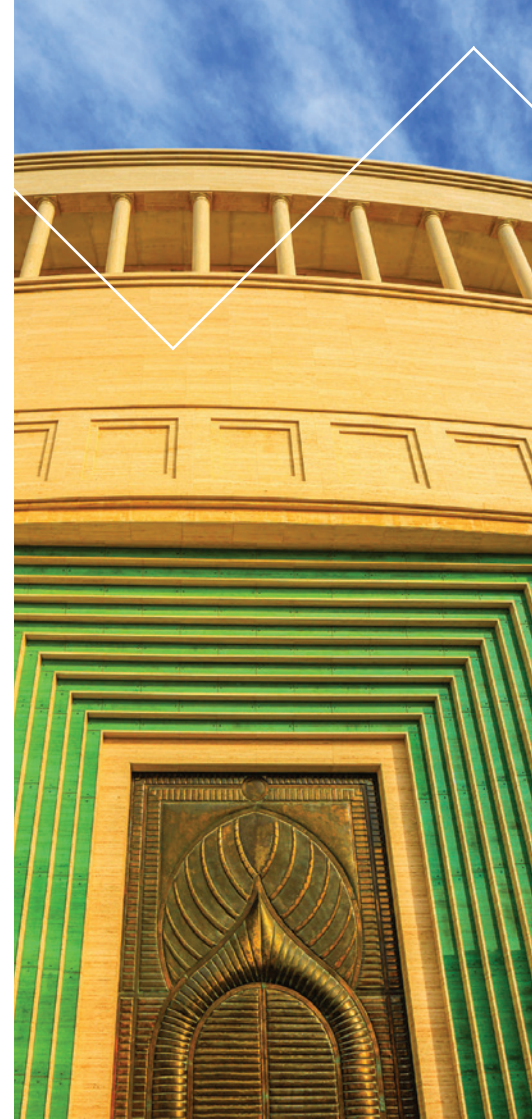


QATAR MUSEUMS GALLERY - KATARA

The QM Gallery is an intimate venue for public art projects in Katara Cultural Village. Located opposite Katara Amphitheatre in building 10, the QM gallery is a casual place that lends itself to weekend browsing.

- **Location:** Katara Cultural Village, Building 10
- **Capacity:** 50 guests, stand-up reception style (atrium)
50 guests, stand-up reception style (courtyard)

Inside gallery space is not available for commercial hire.



BARZAN TOWERS

Originally built as watchtowers, Barzan Tower is the western tower of two that were erected around the Umm Salal Mohammed area in the late 19th century and have now been fully restored. Its T-shape is architecturally unique in the Gulf region.

- **Location:** Umm Salal Mohammed
- **Capacity:** 2000 guests – reception style

Gala dinner space is also available.
Show around tour is advised.



AL ZUBARAH FORT

Located approximately 1 hour west of Doha, Al Zubarah Fort is an important Qatari heritage site. It was built in 1938, during the reign of Sheikh Abdullah Bin Jassim Al-Thani, on the ruins of a neighbouring fort. Al Zubarah Fort offers a unique location for an open-air event. The UNESCO World Heritage Site provides a traditional back drop in a culturally rich setting.

- **Location:** Madinat Al Shamal
- **Capacity:** 2000 guests – stand-up reception style
1000 guests – round table style



IDAM RESTAURANT BY ALAIN DUCASSE

Guests will embark on a refined, generous and enchanted culinary journey at IDAM, Alain Ducasse's first restaurant in the Middle East. In the heart of the Museum of Islamic Art (MIA), with spectacular views of Doha skyline, IDAM offers an innovative and flavoursome selection of contemporary French Mediterranean cuisine designed with an Arabic twist. Executive Chef Damien Leroux recreates the timeless classics of local and regional cuisine, with most ingredients sourced locally in Qatar. Philippe Starck's unique and exquisite decor creates a sophisticated atmosphere.

Culture Pass Club is a new twist on the members-only arts club, located in Doha's burgeoning design hub Msheireb.

- **Capacity:** 200* guests



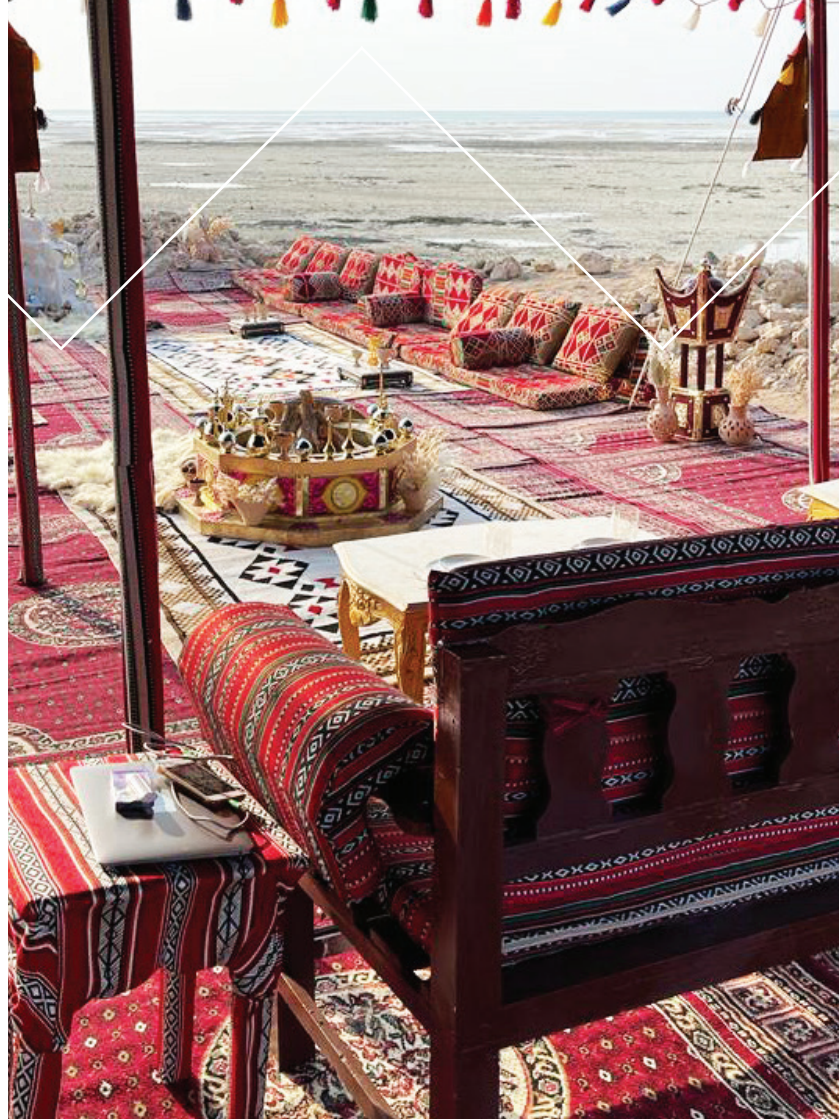
AL JUMAIL VILLAGE

On the north-west coast of Qatar, lies the small traditional but ruined village of Al Jumail. It was inhabited by the Al Kubaisi family, and even nowadays it is still one of the favourite weekend destinations of local families, since it represents their heritage, history, the roots and origin of their ancestors.

The village comprises a set of important traditional buildings, including a small mosque with its minaret still intact. This village dates back to the second half of the 19th century and was still inhabited until the beginning of the 20th century.

- **Location:** North-west Coast of Qatar
- **Capacity:** 50* guests

JIWAN RESTAURANT

Jiwan is located at the top of the museum, on the fourth floor with stunning panoramic views over the aquamarine water of Doha Bay. Named after the Qatari word for the 'perfect pearl', rose-tinted white, completely round with a lustre so pure that it comes alive with radiance, Jiwan is inspired by Qatari Bedouin heritage and rich traditions linked to activities by the sea. Suspended from the ceiling over four million pearl-like crystal beads gently dancing with the air, reflecting Qatar's pearl diving legacy.

- **Location:** NMoQ (4th floor)
- **Capacity:** 120 guests (inside)
120 guests (outside terrace)

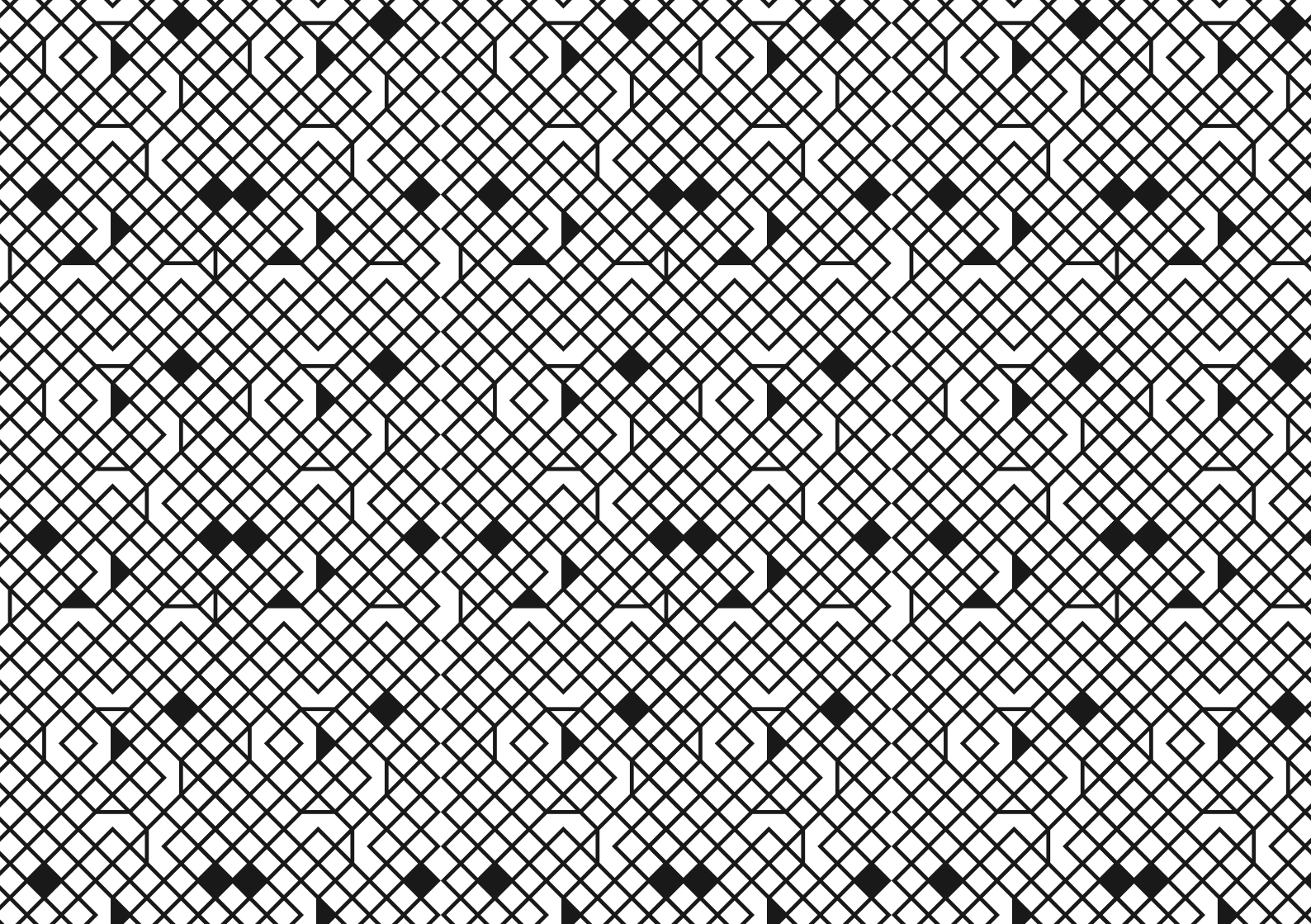
